HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

All registrants are responsible for arranging their own accommodations at the Holiday Inn or another hotel of your choice. To register with the hotel, please complete the hotel registration form and mail it in to the hotel or call the hotel directly and indicate that you are with Lutheran Women's Missionary League-Canada because a block of rooms have been set aside for our convention at a reduced cost. Check in at 3:00 p.m. on Thursday or Friday and check-out at 12:00 noon. High Speed and Wireless internet connections are available in rooms and public spaces.

COMPLETING THE REGISTRATION FORMS

EARLY REGISTRATION

Take advantage of early registration by April 1st and save a few dollars as well as helping LWMLC plan their convention.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

All registration forms must be postmarked by midnight May 8, 2010. Society presidents are encouraged to assist members with the completion of the forms. Registrants will receive confirmation of their registration by e-mail within one week of submission or by land mail within two weeks and in some cases by telephone.

Every individual attending any individual session at the convention will pay registration, with the exception of special invited guests, District Board members and LWML-Canada Ontario District Pastoral Counselor(s) and hosting zone pastors.

REGISTRATION/MEAL PACKAGE

Take advantage of the special registration and meal package being offered to those who attend all sessions and all meals. This is going to be a great convention – you don't want to miss a thing.

REFUNDS

Please be aware that refunds will not be possible after May 31st because there are pre-payments that need to be made to the hotel. Of course, in the case of serious illness or death in the immediate family, please contact the registrar.

PERSONAL INFORMATION

Please print information clearly and complete all sections. The society that you belong to is the name of the church that you are a member of and the city where your church is located.

GENERAL REGISTRATION

Check this box if you are not a delegate or any of the other categories that appear on the form. There is no designated seating at the convention (except for voting members and speakers, etc.) and the tables are usually large round tables that seat 8 to 10 people. You may sit wherever you like.

SOCIETY DELEGATE

Check this box if you are a voting delegate for

your society. You may have more than one box to check. Delegates are seated together near the podium.

ALTERNATE DELEGATE

Check this box if you are the alternate delegate for your society. You may have more than one box to check. Unless you are voting in place of the Society Delegate, you may sit wherever you like.

ZONE PRESIDENT

Check this box if you are the president of one of the seven (7) zones in the Ontario District. You may have more than one box to check. Zone presidents are seated together near the podium.

DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Check this box if you are a voting member of the District Board of Directors. You may have more than one box to check.

YOUNG WOMEN UNDER 36

If you are a women under the age of 36 and you wish to be contacted by the young women's representative, please check this box. You may have more than one box to check.

WINDSOR ZONE COMMITTEE & VOLUNTEERS

If you are on the Convention Committee for the Windsor Zone, please check this box so that your name tag will properly identify you as part of the host committee. You may have more than one box to check. If you are from the Windsor Zone but not on the committee, please check General Registration.

PASTORAL COUNSELORS

If you are the pastoral counselor for one of the seven zones in Ontario, please check this box. You may have more than one box to check.

SPECIAL GUESTS

If you have been invited as a special guest or a speaker or an entertainer, please complete the registration form because we require your personal information.

EXHIBITORS

If you are setting up an exhibit, please check the exhibitor's box and any other designation that applies to you.

PAGES

If you will be serving as a page, please check that box. You may have more than one box to check. Pages will be seated together.

FOOD ALLERGIES/RESTRICTIONS

If you have any special dietary needs or

allergies to any specific foods, please indicate that on the form. If you wish to provide any additional information, write it on the back of the registration form. The information you provide will be submitted to the Dietary Department of the Hotel and your meal tickets may be marked accordingly also.

SPECIAL NEEDS

If you require any special accommodations that you would like help with, please let us know by writing this on the back of your registration form and we will try to help.

CONVENTION CHOIR

If you indicate you would like to sing in the choir your name will be submitted to Rachel Whittal who will send music directly to your address. Please indicate if you are Soprano, 2nd Soprano or Alto. If you love to sing you will love being in the choir. The choir will gather on Thursday evening between 6 and 7 pm.

PHOTOGRAPHY

During the convention, a photographer will be taking pictures at random and these photos may be posted in different media. Please indicate by checking the appropriate box if you give permission for any photos of you to be published in LWMLC Media.

COMMUNION SERVICE – THURS. 7:30 PM

There will be a communion service on Thursday evening with both individual and common cup available. Please indicate your preference on the registration form along with your intent to partake of the Lord's Supper.
