

JESUS, LIGHT OF THE WORLD VISOR

Adults and children/youth making visors to share the Gospel

Visors, as headgear, have become popular. Here is a design that children, youth or the young at heart will love to wear as they proclaim their love for Jesus on special occasions like picnics, vacation Bible schools, parades, zone rallies and the like. What a wonderful way to reveal our Saviour. The visor tells it all in the words "Jesus is the Light of the world."

Making the visor can provide an excellent opportunity for children and LWML–Canada members to interact. You might make or provide the materials so each Sunday school or VBS child has one. You might make one for yourselves as well and find opportunities for adults and children together to wear them.

Supplies required:

- A half circle (diameter 30-35cm, or 12"- 14") of cardboard (can be from cereal box, etc.)
- a copy of the visor picture
- crayons or markers of different colors
- a rubber band or elastic
- glue

Directions:

- Have the children colour the picture of Jesus, Light of the world.
- Paste it on the cardboard.
- Let the glue dry.
- Cut around the picture.
- Punch holes in the upper points as indicated by the small circles.
- Insert a piece of elastic, one end into each hole, adjusting to the size of the head of each child and fastening (with a knot, sewing or a safety pin).

As an alternative, the visor can be made from coloured fun foam. Using the picture as a pattern, pieces could be cut out for the various parts and then glued to a cardboard backing or a white piece of fun foam cut to the outside shape of the design. Complete with as above with the elastic.
